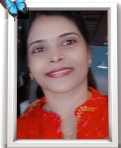

Brief History of School

The Maharaja of Vizianagaram, His Highness Sri Ananda Gajapathi Raju took the initiative and founded the school in 1890 and maintained the School in George Town locality. After a brief period, it was transferred to the care of the National Indian Association.

Messrs. Thiruvengadathan Chetty, Rao Bahadur Calavala Cunnan Chetty and Dewan Bahadur Calavala Ramanujam Chetty, the generous hearted businessmen made contributions for the maintenance of the school. But the actual Management of the school was under the control of the National Indian Association.

In the year 1924, the President of National Indian Association, Sir Charles Todhunter, K.C S I, I.C. S. requested the Sri Kanyaka Parameswari Devasthanam and Charities to take up the Management of the School and to receive the contributions from the estate of the Calavala Brothers. As it was maintained by the Calavala brothers, the school was named Kalavala Thiruvengadathan Chetty.

Under the Management of S.K.P.D. and Charities, the school made a rapid progress. The School was functioning as Higher Elementary School till 1938. The Management was very keen to cater to the needs of the Telugu population of the locality. In 1943, the school was converted into a Telugu Girls School. By 1944, they made all necessary arrangements to repair and remodel the building at No.58, Narayana Mudali Street, Madras-1, which was once purchased by the Calavala Brothers for running the school and got permission from the Government to convert the school into a Middle School.

In the year 1945-1946, Higher Grade Elementary School was converted into the New Middle school which was named as the K.T.C. Telugu Girls' Middle School. It was popularly known as Bommavaalla school as the students received a Wooden Doll as a gift or prize.

The Elementary School Section was inspected by the Sub-Assistant Inspectress, Mrs. G. Conron. She has recorded her appreciation on the improvement of the school. In 1945, Her Excellency Lady Hope paid a visit to our school. She was welcomed by the Management. She greatly appreciated the progress of the school.

The School was upgraded as High School with Form IV in 1947, Form V in 1948 and Form VI in 1949.

In the whole of Madras city, this was the only Girls' High School where Telugu is the Medium of instruction. This school was undoubtedly a great boon to the Andhra population of the locality.



The **Motto** of the school is "Speak the Truth, Do the Right".

Highlights of the School

- The First Batch of students were sent for S.S.L.C. Examination in March 1950.
- Our Girl Guides welcomed **Lady Baden Powell** at Wenlock Park on 6th January 1961.
- They participated in welcoming **Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth** on 19th Feb' 1961.
- The students welcomed **Dr. S. Radhakrishnan, President of the Indian Union** when he visited the S.K.P.D. Temple on 3rd January 1962.
- The **Governor, Sri Bishnuram Medhi** inspected the A.C.C. and Guides of our school on 22nd April 1962.
- In 1978, the School was upgraded to Higher Secondary School with 10+2+3 new pattern of Education.
- The School had been declared as a minority institution as per the orders of the city Civil Court dated 12-11-79.
- Human Computer, **Shakuntala Devi**, First Lady Mathematician in India was the Guest Speaker of our school.
- S.K.P.D. & Charities provided nutritious food daily for the needy students.
- **Dr. C.M.K. Reddy**, presided over the School Anniversary in 1980 and in 2019
- **Dr. H.V. Hande**, Hon'ble Minister for Health and Family Welfare, presided the School Anniversary in 1983
- Our students presented Cultural programmes:
 - In 1991 for Children's day celebrations, the Chief Guest was **Dr. V. R. Nedunchezhiyan**, Finance Minister of Tamil Nadu.
 - In 1992 for Dr. M. G. Ramachandran Birthday Celebration, the Chief Guest was **Dr. J. Jayalalitha**, Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu.
 - In 1992 for Republic Day Parade the Chief Guest was **Shri Bhishma Narain Singh, Governor of Tamil Nadu** and **Dr. J. Jayalalitha, Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu**.
- Introduction of Internet was done on 12th August 1997, **Thiru R. Theivamani, Director of School Education**, Government of Tamil Nadu was the Chief Guest and **Sri P.Perumal Swami, Joint Director of School Education**, graced the occasion.
- Our students had secured State Ranks in Advanced Telugu, Political Science and Telugu,



First Prize in District Level Science Exhibition, Inspire Award and National Means Merit Scholarship.

- Tamil Language has been introduced under Part I, initially for Standard XI and XII and then for Standard VI to X. As ours is a Linguistic Minority Institution, with the support of eminent persons, our students are continuing to write their Board Exam under Part I in their Mother Tongue, Telugu.
- To inculcate a sense of nationalism and patriotism in every child, national functions such as Independence Day and Republic Day are celebrated with much pomp under the single umbrella of S.K.P.D. & Charities.
- All the religious festivals and National days like Education day, Teacher's day, Children's day and Gandhi Jayanthi are celebrated with great enthusiasm.
- Opportunities to nurture the talents of the students are provided through participation in the Literary Associations and Club activities.
- Music, Drama, Dance, Yoga, Quiz, Science Exhibitions, Debates, Project work, planting of trees, gardening are a part of the curriculum.
- Expert speakers from various walks of life are invited from time to time to motivate and inspire the students.
- Students also participate in the All India Radio programs in Telugu every year.
- Our school is the Centre for conducting Public Practical and Theory Exam for Standard X, XI, & XII and for Exams like UPSC, TNPSC and Naan Mudalvan.
- Welfare Schemes enforced by Tamil Nadu Government are being implemented in our school.
- Alumni Association and other clubs have been a source of great help in providing amenities to the school and giving educational assistance to meritorious students.

A 100-year-Old, Linguistic Minority Institution, a Government Aided school (1924-2024), located in the heart of the city, focuses on free education by talented teachers following traditional method and modern technology using Digital and Smart Boards. The school is proud of its eminent Teachers, who have built up sound traditions of high learning coupled with exemplary conduct.

We have a lot of notable achievements with successful aluminates. We strongly believe 'Education is a foundation upon which one builds the future'. We are providing opportunities for the students to learn and explore.

Past and Present Members of the Managing Committee, Secretaries and Educational Advisors of S.K.P.D. & Charities have been doing their best for the overall development of this Institution. They are taking extreme interest in providing the amenities required to run the school on par with other private institutions.

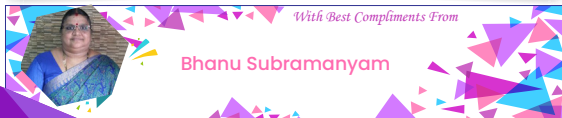
